

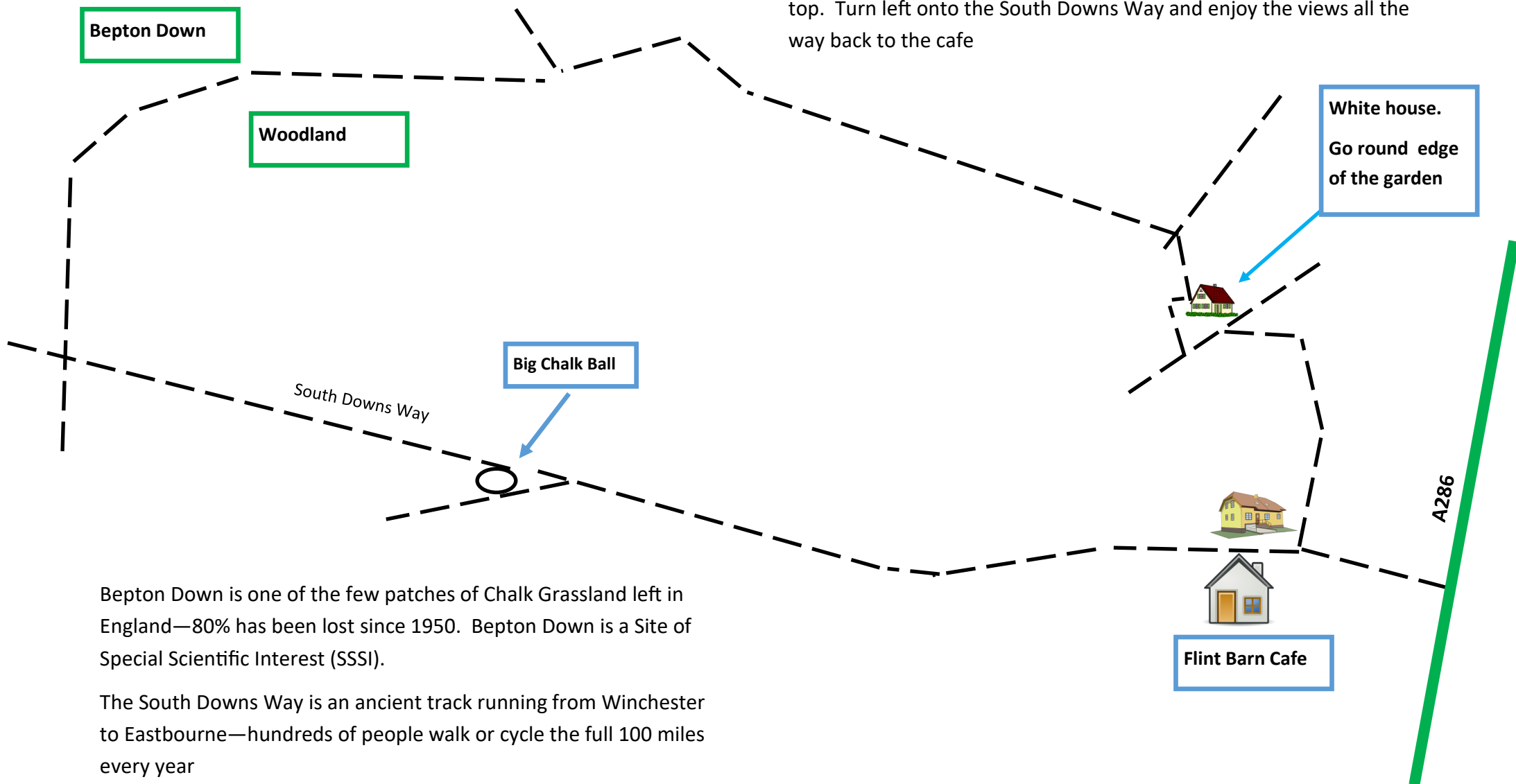
Henley Lane Walk

2.77 miles—some steep climbs between the White House (Crypt Farm) and just past Bepton Down.

Start at Post Code GU29 0HT

Directions

Go down the track opposite Flint Barn Café (in front of the houses). Follow the track to the bottom of the hill and turn left at the white house. Follow the track around their garden. When you come to a track on the right—keep going straight. Now the big climb starts—just keep going, past the iconic Chalk Grassland of Bepton Down, all the way to the top. Turn left onto the South Downs Way and enjoy the views all the way back to the cafe



Bepton Down is one of the few patches of Chalk Grassland left in England—80% has been lost since 1950. Bepton Down is a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI).

The South Downs Way is an ancient track running from Winchester to Eastbourne—hundreds of people walk or cycle the full 100 miles every year
